

LEARN TO SKATE INFORMATION

Winter Showcase 2024

The winter showcase is an optional exhibition show where skaters get to show off the skills they have mastered. All Learn to Skate skaters are encouraged to participate! Based on participation numbers, Learn to Skate skaters will be grouped into smaller groups based on skill levels.

*members of Sychro lines are expected to participate in Winter Showcase & will be working on their program during their weekly lessons, synchro will practice an extra time on Sunday December 15 between 4:30-5:00pm.

Costume: Costumes will be borrowed to skaters by NIFSC at no additional cost.

Cost: \$30, includes ice time, coaching, costume (borrowing), & two (2) parent tickets

 \$15 for Synchro as an add-on, includes additional practice, coaching, & costume
 IF not participating in the LTS group number, synchro members will be charged \$25 to include two parent tickets.

Sign Up: **Sign-up deadline will be Sunday December 1.**

Winter showcase will take place on Sunday December at 5:00pm. Warm-up ice will start at 4:30pm and go until about 4:45pm when we will take a brief break for the zamboni to run. Show will start at 5:00pm. Skater locker room(s) will be available for skaters to change into their costumes if they choose to utilize one.

Show Specific Information:

Winter showcase will take place on Sunday December 22nd. Warm up ice for LTS skaters will be from 5:00-5:30pm. Doors will open to the public at 5:30pm, show will start at 6:00pm.

Admission – admission for this event is \$5/person. This will be general admission event and all tickets will be sold at the door. Cash, Check or Credit/Debit will be accepted.

Congratulatory Digital Display -before/during intermission/after the show there will be custom messages displayed on the digital display boards. You can purchase one for your skater for \$10/slide. This includes a custom message & 1-3 photos of your skater displayed in a rotation with ads and other congratulatory messages.
